Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to inform you of some changes to our Data Protection systems from May 25th. New legislation will come into effect on this date and we are required by law to inform you of how we as a setting will implement this.

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) is new EU law which invokes greater responsibility on businesses to protect the data held. They also put accountability on us being transparent and clearly communicating how your data is collected, processed and stored. These new regulations, alongside the new Data Protection Bill, mean that we must inform you of the data we hold, our lawful basis for processing this, how we use this information and how it is protected. Further information can be found in the attached privacy statement and data protection policy.

It is important that you read both of these documents carefully. If you have any questions regarding the content please discuss this with the Data Protection Officer/Lead for our setting who is Sue Butler or your Nursery Manager.

Much of the information we request from you (by way of your child's registration form) we have a legal obligation to collect as required by The Early Years Foundation Stage (Welfare Requirements) Regulations 2012. Where our basis for processing data is either legal obligation or legitimate interest we are not required to seek consent from you to hold this information. All of our forms for collecting data have been amended to inform you which data is mandatory and which is voluntary.

Where we do require consent, such as for displays or using images, we will do so separately using relevant forms and a signature will be necessary to confirm your consent. You should be aware that you do not have to give consent and that where you do; this can be withdrawn at any time as the new regulations allow.

We have always ensured that all data held by us regarding you and your child is secure. We will endeavour to continue to protect your information against unauthorised access, damage, loss or theft as we have always done.

This is the biggest change to data protection legislation in twenty years. Whilst we already meet the majority of the GDPR we have been updating our systems and processes over the last few weeks to ensure we are fully compliant.

To ensure that we are totally compliant with the General Data Protection Regulation (May 2018) it is a requirement for each parent to complete the revised registration form and contract; please do return to nursery before 25th May.
